## University of Economics in Bratislava

**Short description:** The University of Economics in Bratislava (UEBA) is the most specialised public research institution in the Slovak Republic in the area of economics, business and management with region-specific knowledge and professional network in the Central and East European region, it comprises 7 faculties, the Bratislava Business School, and the Economics and Management Institute. It provides higher education in 61 bachelor's, master's and doctoral programmes for full-time and part-time students. All students have the opportunity to study economics- and business-related programmes on a par with the European standards, several of which can also be studied in English, German, French, Spanish or Russian languages.

**Scientific research, international relations, projects:** Being the largest university – type centre of basic and applied research in economics, business and management in Slovakia and operating in the European Research Area, UEBA is engaged with its partners on the basis of the Erasmus+ Programme (308 agreements with universities in 37 countries) and the international cooperation platform. It is a member of prestigious international organisations such as the European University Association, the International Association of Universities and the European Doctoral Programmes Association in Management and Business Administration. UEBA as one of the signatories of the Magna Charta Universitatum is in the process of AACSB International accreditation, emphasising engagement, innovation and impact. Thus, UEBA research capacity is often applied to design solutions or to upgrade existing processes for business.
