Trnava University in Trnava

Short description: Historical Trnava University represents one of the oldest universities in Slovakia. The Trnava University was established by Cardinal Peter Pázmaň in 1635 and consisted of four faculties: faculty of theology, arts, law and medicine. The University became well-known also thanks to an observatory founded by Maximilián Hell, a university library, gardens and a theatre. The University existed for 142 years and in 1777, it was moved to Buda. The present Trnava University was re-opened in July 1992. Trnava University is one of the most prestigious universities in Slovakia. The University Statute emphasises the compliance with the principles of Magna Charta of the European universities and Christian principles, preaching and teaching truth, freedom and humanitarian ideals of mankind, protecting moral and spiritual values and educating students in the spirit of ecumenism, tolerance and mutual respect.
