projects: Scientific research orientation of SUA covers a wide range of agricultural, technical, social



and economic sciences in the field of basic and applied research, within the framework of which the significant AgroBioTech research centre contributes to the improvement. In the area of research activities, SUA is involved in projects of the 7th Framework Programme, COST, new programme Horizon 2020 and European Structural Funds, in the field of international educational activities the most important project among others is the new European programme Erasmus+ (2014–2020). The university has 177 bilateral agreements within the Erasmus Programme and over 100 inter-university cooperation agreements worldwide. SUA is a member of the Global Consortium for Higher Education in Agriculture, the European University Association, the Danube Rectors' Conference, the Association for European Life Science Universities and is a founding member of the Visegrad University Association.
