Research at the University of Prešov is mainly in the areas of social sciences, natural sciences, theological sciences, physical education and sport, management,



fine arts and health care. At present, the university is involved in several scientific projects, including Innovation vouchers granted from the Ministry of Economy of the SR and from the Prešov self-governing region, the international V4 projects and also several projects within the Horizon 2020 were submitted. The University of Prešov has established outstanding centres of excellence, namely the Centre for Human and Animal Ecology, the Centre for Socio-Historical Research and the Lingual-Cultural and Translational – Interpretation Centre. The University of Prešov is a member of the Danube Rectors' Conference, the European University Association and the Alliance of the Central-Eastern European Universities. It is participating in the EU education and training programmes such as Erasmus+ KA1, Erasmus KA2 and CEEPUS.
